

inLIFE Pilates Certification (WA) - Terms and Conditions

These Terms and Conditions apply to all students enrolled in the inLIFE Pilates Certification (WA) program. By enrolling in this program, you agree to the following:

By proceeding with payment, you acknowledge and agree to these Terms and Conditions in full.

Please note: We follow the national inLIFE Pilates Certification framework, however, our WA program operates with **unique delivery methods, assessment timelines, and terms & conditions**. These have been specifically designed to meet the needs of our Western Australian student cohort and studio operations.

1. Eligibility and Enrolment

- Students must be 18 years or older.
 - Students are responsible for providing accurate information during enrolment.
 - Enrolment is confirmed upon receipt of payment.

2. Certification Pathway

- Students will receive **Provisional Certification** upon completing all online modules and the 3-day in-person Group Reformer Pilates training.
 - Full certification is granted after:
 - Attending 10 Pilates classes as a member
 - Observing 6 classes
 - Completing 10 hours of practice teaching
 - Attending 2 mentoring workshops
 - Passing a practical assessment at 3 and 6 months
 - All requirements must be completed within 6 months unless an extension is granted in writing.

3. Studio Access and Equipment

- Students are encouraged to attend classes at any Pilates studio of their choice.
 - inLIFE Wellness offers discounted Instructor Memberships to provisional students.
 - Practice access to inLIFE studios is limited and not guaranteed. All practice access must be pre-approved by studio managers.

4. Refund Policy

- **No refunds** will be provided once payment is made under any circumstances.
 - Students who are unable to complete the course may request a **one-time credit transfer** to the next available course intake.
 - Deferral requests must be submitted in writing prior to the commencement of the practical training block.
 - Credits are non-transferable to other programs or individuals.

5. Assessment & Retakes

- Students who do not pass the final practical assessment may retake it for a fee of \$200.
 - Additional mentoring and observation requirements may be imposed prior to reassessment.

6. Certification Validity & CPD

- Certification remains valid only if annual **Continuing Professional Development (CPD)** requirements are met.
 - 30 CPD points must be logged annually. Activities include workshops, mentoring, and peer-based training.
 - inLIFE Wellness may audit CPD logs and revoke certification for non-compliance.

7. Code of Conduct

- Students must maintain professional conduct at all times.
 - Any behaviour deemed unsafe, disrespectful, or unethical may result in expulsion from the program.

8. Use of Certification and Branding

- The "inLIFE Certified Instructor" designation may only be used by students who have met all requirements and remain in good standing.
 - Use of inLIFE logos or branding must be pre-approved.

9. Jurisdiction

- These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of **Western Australia**.

- Any disputes will be resolved under WA jurisdiction.
